Seminary and Scholarship Fund update-

As many of you know, the tuition and living expenses for our Bible College and Seminary students has increased greatly for the upcoming semester.

Seminary- Fall semester we have 3 students attending Seminary. At the annual meeting the congregation voted to pay half of tuition/housing/utilities for each student for the spring semester. If we were to do that for the fall semester, we would need approximately \$22,575.00. The current balance in the Seminary Fund is \$8,549.11.

Bible College- Fall semester we have 5 students attending FLBC. In the past we have tried to pay half the tuition/room/board for each student. If we were to do that the fall semester we would need \$25,000. The current balance in the scholarship fund is \$20,152.88.

Pray that God will provide for all of our students. If you wish to donate for fall semester, please do so by September 15.
